Cree River Lodge, located in the far reaches of unspoiled northern Saskatchewan, features some of the best northern pike and walleye fishing in the world. We know that is a bold statement. We also know it is true.

Most Canadian lodges boast the occasional northern pike in the 40-inch range. Cree River Lodge all but guarantees you'll have a chance at multiple 40-inchers, with a real possibility of battling giant pike more than 45 inches long and perhaps even catching a big brute of the coveted 50-inch class.

Walleye in the 2- to 5-pound range are abundant and easily caught on simple tackle. We have some of the best walleye fishing in all of Saskatchewan, especially during the summer months.

And for a true north-country fishing experience, Arctic grayling, the "high-spirited leapers", are a short boat ride from the lodge. Fly-out day trips to one of our four outpost lakes are also available, providing access to virtually virgin trophy lakes teeming with lake trout, pike and walleve.

Whether fly-fishing, using conventional tackle, or both, you are in for some of the most exciting fishing you've ever experienced.


